



THOUGHT-PROVOKING “FUN HOUSE”

Recreated from the original 1965 Argentinian performance installation, Mata Minujin's "La Menesunda Reloaded" (Confusing Situation) is a multi-chambered trip though vignettes where neon, foam rubber, tape, Styrofoam, a makeup artist, a couple reading in bed, a spinning platform create visual and tactile experiences which are humorous, silly, thoughtful, provocative. Guests one-at-a time enter through a plastic cutout silhouette. While awaiting your turn, , consider viewing four additional single-artist shows on view at the New Museum.

MOON STRUCK

Galileo drew pictures of the moon, but its surface couldn't be mapped until pioneer photographers synchronized cameras and telescopes to accommodate rotation of the moving bodies. "Apollo's Muse: The Moon in the Age of Photography" exhibits early photographs along with instruments, pictures, and wildly imaginative films, concluding with the television broadcast of the Apollo 11 landing. Artworks across the hall show paintings, photos, garments, creations influenced by the moon exploration.
