
#### **Dress for Success Palm Beach**

Inside this year's luncheon with Style Icon awardees Tommy and Dee Ocleppo Hilfiger.





Before two abusive marriages, she had aspired to model and her first runway job happened to be modeling a Tommy Hilfiger outfit. Accepting their award, the Hilfigers commended the organization and held a discussion with news anchor Shannon Cake describing to the crowd how they met and how they work together on their separate successful design businesses.


